Drive out to Origins Classics, then to Sticks & Stones Café, Woodborough

The proprietor of Origins Classics, Cameron Brownlee, has kindly invited Branch Members to view the classics in storage or for sale in his barn near Avebury, and has planned a route over the Wiltshire Downs to the Sticks and Stones Cafe, Woodborough. We depart from Studley Grange Garden Centre at 9:00; arrive Origins Classics at 9:30. Depart from there 10:30, arrive Sticks and Stones 11:00 for coffee. You are then free to explore the shops adjacent to Sticks and Stones, which include: Whitehall Garden Centre (which also has a café); Le Marché Bric-à-Brac; Merlin Glass Studio; Digger & Mojo Antiques & Interiors.

Please make your own arrangements for lunch. It is available at Sticks and Stones or at the cafe in the Garden Centre. If you follow the same route back, there are a couple of car parks which make good picnic spots (you will see them on the way out). You could also consider the Barge Inn at Honeystreet or the Red Lion at Avebury, both of which are on the route.

On the way back you might like to visit the Saxon Church, St Mary's, at Alton Barnes, or park at the car park at Knap Hill and take a short walk up to one of the highest points in Wiltshire, Walkers Hill, or of course stop to see the stones and the Great Barn at Avebury. Full route details on the day.
