The national club will be collecting for the Notts and Lincs Air Ambulance, which recently saved the life of an MMOC member (she was present in the meeting) and branches are encouraged to donate to this or to their local Air Ambulance - North Wilts Branch has supported this many times in the past.

Bruce Kelsey is undertaking a comprehensive member consultation over the next 6 months to develop a ten-year plan for the MMOC. We are encouraged to respond by mail or online to the questionnaires to be published in *Minor Matters*, and to discuss the issues at branch level.
