For me, the star of the show was the 1938 Morris 14/6 displayed by the Morris Register.







## One of only six built for export to the Kenyan government in 1938. This is the only known survivor of the six. The car was used extensively by government officials in Nairobi mainly carrying diplomats on state visits. The car had done 187000 miles during that time and was very well maintained, no expense spared!. Arthur Peeling (the former owner and Morris Register membership Secretary) purchased the car whilst in Kenya during 1954 after the Kenyan government upgraded their fleet of cars. He re-imported the car to the UK in that year and set about restoring the vehicle to its former state. The battery of headlights were fitted as pre ordered by the Kenyan government as were the horns.
