Cameron has some really interesting and rare vehicles in storage, on display and for sale; and he has lots of stories about them. On the day of our visit he had a Fiat 500 Giardiniera (equivalent of the Traveller, but smaller and rear-engined) and the "press" Mini which belonged to motoring journalist John Bolster (see here for a wonderful period photo).
